



P&C Update – February 2021



The P&C would like to warmly welcome all new and returning children and families to the wonderful Mudgee Public School community for 2021. We hope everyone is settling well into school.

About the P&C

The P&C is a group of supportive and friendly parents, carers and community members who work together for the benefit of children at Mudgee Public School. It's a great way to meet other families and get to know more about what is happening at the school. You don't have to attend every meeting or volunteer at events - you can be involved for as much or as little time as suits you and your family. You can even join and simply receive emails with information about decisions and planned events. If you are interested in joining, please fill out the membership form attached to this newsletter and drop it into the front office or bring your form to a P&C meeting.

What We Do:

- We encourage communication and cooperation within the school community.
- Operate the canteen and uniform shop with all profit reinvested back into the school.
- Run a variety of community and fundraising events designed to bring the school community together as well as raising funds.
- Organise grant applications for school resources.
- Advocate for students on behalf of the school community.

Funding:

All money raised from fundraising, the canteen and uniform shop is given back to the school to help with resources and activities for children. In 2020, the P&C contributed funds to help buy books to assist the school counsellor, Adelle Bungate, in working with children who have experienced bereavement. The P&C also contributed \$6500 to cover the cost of buses for all school excursions in term 4, 2020. Usually the cost of excursions would be spread out over the year but last

year, many excursions were delayed until term 4 which meant a large cost to families over only a few weeks. The P&C wanted to help keep the cost of excursions low so as many children as possible may have the opportunity to attend.

Meetings

The P&C meets on Monday in week 2 and week 8 of each school term at 6pm. Mr Carters attends every meeting and is a wonderful resource for information about what (and why) things are happening at the school. Questions and suggestions are always very welcome!

You can come along in person – meetings are held in the school residence (corner of Perry and Denison Streets) or you can attend remotely via Zoom. All parents, carers, grandparents and family members are welcome to attend. **The first meeting for 2021 will be held on Monday, 8**th **February at 6pm.** We'll be getting to know each other and going over P&C plans for the year.

CANTEEN

The canteen is open every day from 8.45am to 2pm and provides fresh, tasty and nutritious food to fuel growing minds and bodies. The canteen is managed by Tracey (pictured with her son, Owen). With the help of canteen assistant, Jemma



and many lovely volunteers, Tracey cooks most meals from scratch with lots of added fruit and veggies. The lasagne, hamburgers, torpedo rolls and sushi are all packed full of extra veggies and very popular with kids (and teachers!). How to order:

Online: Orders can be placed quickly and easily online at www.quickcliq.com.au. Online orders close at 9am each day.

At school: You can also send your child's lunch order and money to the canteen in a lunch bag. Please write your child's name, class and order on a paper bag, place money in the bag and remind your child to put their order in the canteen basket in their classroom at the beginning of the day.

For recess, food may be ordered in advance or children can come down to the canteen to choose from a range of freshly prepared recess specials. Please order lunch in advance. Recess orders need to be collected by your child from the canteen; lunch orders are sent to classrooms.

Volunteer in the Canteen: We couldn't do without volunteers in the canteen. Last year, Tracey, Jemma and the canteen volunteers prepared over 8700 meals! Kids love seeing a familiar face in the canteen and by volunteering in the canteen, you are helping to keep prices affordable. All profit from the canteen is given back to the school so by donating your time to the canteen, you really are helping the children of Mudgee Public School! All relatives and carers are welcome. No cooking skills are required – Tracey and Jemma will always be able to find a job for you! Lunch, tea and coffee are supplied as well as plenty of laughs!

You can volunteer any day or time that suits you. Even just 1 hour to sort orders in the morning or to pack baskets before lunch is a big help. We also have a roster where we ask families from a specific class each week to make a special effort for that week and consider volunteering in the canteen. Unfortunately, due to safety reasons, children cannot come into the canteen We know many people would love to volunteer but have

to care for young children during school hours. If this is you, please don't worry! We thank you for your intention and perhaps you may be able volunteer in the future.
