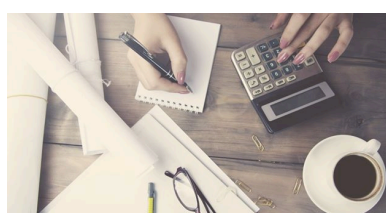
P&C Update
