### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Thank you to all parents and carers who have picked up the work packs for their children. Term 2 has started!! It is important that you engage your child in learning again, after the relaxing holidays. We will be continuing to develop online learning

as well as work packs while we are in the early Phases. **Phase 1** learning begins next week and involves every student attending school on one set day a week. Students will be supervised in Year/Stage groups with various teachers during the day. Students will continue to do the one unit of online learning either at school or at home.

# How will Mudgee Public encourage social distancing at school?

From Week 3 we will be staggering home times. As explained in the newsletter last week, students who are picked up or who walk home will be leaving school at 3pm. Bus students will go to bus lines at the normal time of 3.15pm. Parents are asked to drop off their children at the school gates. There will be supervision to support students to go from the gate to the school playground.

# How will Mudgee Public support good hygiene?

Students are asked to bring refillable drink bottles and can access our 'stand up bubblers' for refilling only. Students should bring their own pencil case to school and take it home each day. Students will

continue to be given regular reminders about good hygiene around handwashing techniques and social distancing. The professional cleaners that work within our school have put in place enhanced cleaning measures. This includes significantly more cleaning time each day to ensure that high touch surfaces are thoroughly cleaned.

#### How is attendance monitored?

Students working from home will continue to be placed on 'Flexible Leave'. This is considered 'present' at school. Students that are not completing any learning at home, after being contacted by their teacher will be marked as 'Unexplained'.

### LIBRARY NEWS


