Afternoon Pick-ups and the Bus Zone

I have spoken to the police this morning about the use of the bus zone for pick ups in the afternoon. As mentioned yesterday, pick-ups in the afternoon will remain the same as last term, with students who don't catch the bus will be leaving at 3:00pm. Bus students will be dismissed at 3:15pm. Parents are permitted to use the bus stop between 3:00pm and 3:15pm to pick up students. However, parents are not allowed to park in this area for prolonged periods of time. The area should be used for quick pick ups. We ask that if your child is not there that you please move on and come back when they are ready for collection. Staff will be there to assist. If you arrive after 3:15, you will need to park elsewhere, as this area will then be designated for the buses. The police will be enforcing as a bus zone once buses start arriving. We hope that this is helpful for families. Please support our endeavours to make this easy by following these guidelines. This in turn will help keep all our students safe.
