Sign up to share your child's progress and let the funds roll in. Your child can earn virtual badges along the way and your page will highlight the prizes up for grabs.



Enrolment forms are available from the school office. Bookings are essential! Pick up your forms now and don't miss out on your preferred spot. The NSW Department of Education states: 'Regular attendance at school is essential for students to achieve quality life outcomes. Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment

• being required to attend a recognised religious holiday

• exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record.'

*Please send in a note with your child when they return to school after any absence. Alternatively you can ring the school office and leave a message as to why your child has been away.
