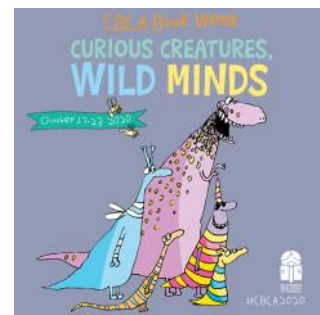
## LIBRARY NEWS
