These students will receive a \$50 prize.

Overall, year 6 students achieved 7 High Distinctions. These students were Grady Vitnell, Jessica Halbisch, Max Wolfson, Billy Blackman, Jarrah Leary, Patrick Holleman and Riley Hargraves. Two year 6 students gained Distinctions - Cooper Crowe and Tilly James. In year 5, two students were awarded Distinctions, congratulations to Christian Muscat & Lachlan Williams. This is a wonderful achievement by all students who certainly have a flare for mathematics!
