### Year 4 Excursions to Red Hill

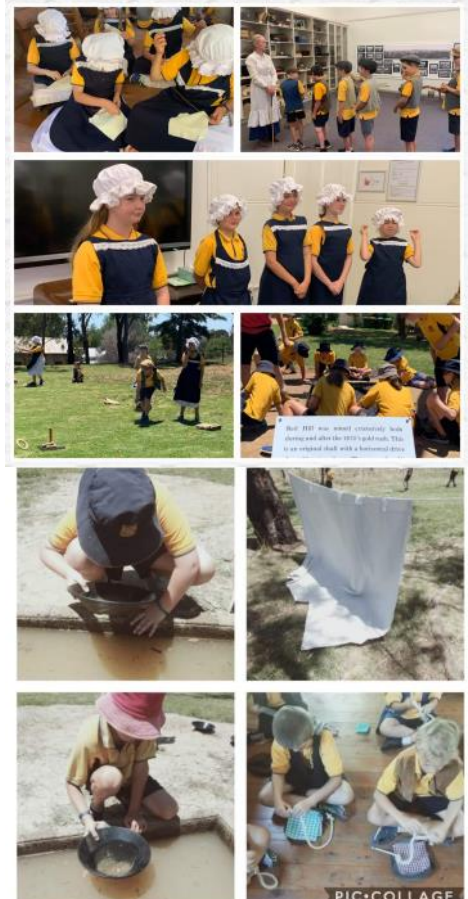
Year 4 had some very warm days for their excursion, but it all turned out to be a wonderful experience. What did Year 4 learn?
